
### Notice of the period for the exercise of public rights and other information required by Regulation 15(2), Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015

1. In respect of the annual accounts for Wanborough Parish Council (“WPC”) for the year ending 31 March 2024, we declare the statement of accounts will not be audited on account of WPC’s self-certified status as exempt, unless either a request for an opportunity to question the auditor about the authority’s accounting records under section 26(2) or an objection under section 27(1) of the Act, results in the involvement of the local auditor, and that in either of these circumstances the audit will be limited to that required by section 30 of the Act as modified by the Smaller Authorities Regulations.
2. We declare that the annual governance statement has been prepared in accordance with regulation 6(1)(b).
3. For the year 2023/24 WPC’s certificate of exemption, annual internal audit report, annual governance statement, accounting statements, analysis of variances and bank reconciliation are available to view on our website: [www.wanboroughpc.uk](http://www.wanboroughpc.uk)
4. The period for the exercise of public rights will commence on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> June 2024 and run for a period of 30 days until 21<sup>st</sup> July 2024.
